Young Adult Winter Retreat - What Do You Want?

Marion Presbyterian Church has a long-standing relationship with Westminster Woods. We can trace this connection back to Rev. Bill Nelson and youth from our church going to camp when the campers stayed in covered wagons! In recent years, we would send campers to camp by paying 50% of their registration fee. This resulted in a handful of kids going to camp each summer. Then two summers ago, the Session (Elders) decided to spend some money we had in a fund named Youth Camp Fund. For the last two summers, we have been paying the full registration fee for students who attend our church or our Christian Ed program and we have continued to pay 50% for students who are not affiliated with our congregation. The students love attending Westminster Woods where their faith is nurtured, friendships are established or grown, and they encounter the love of Christ!
